# LOOK OUT FOR SNAKES

Hot weather has bought out snakes & lizards so watch out for these creatures and make sure that you know what to do in the event of a snake bite.

This region is home to potentially deadly venomous snakes including the dark skinned Mulga and the Western Brown variations of which may be orange with a black head, or yellow head with greenish body, some have black bands. Don't confuse this with the harmless Desert Banded Snake which grows to only 40cm long, or the Ringed Brown which is venomous but not dangerous, growing up to 60cm.

A good practice is to keep a large, firm pressure bandage at hand in your car and home.



**HEALTH ALERT** - ROSS RIVER FEVER NOW IN THIS REGION. Be alert about spread of other mosquito carried medical conditions. Watch out for mosquitoes, cover up & regularly apply mozzie repellent when outdoors. Don't leave water lying around that encourages breeding. Keep

door & window screens closed.
